OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN POLICE COLLEGE

WRITTEN PROCEDURE FOR

**AMENDING THE ANNUAL WORK PROGRAMME 2016:
ADDING TWO RESIDENTIAL ACTIVITIES**

Adopted by the Governing Board via written procedure
on 18 May 2016

THE GOVERNING BOARD,

Having regard to Council Decision 2005/681/JHA of 20 September 2005 establishing the European Police College (CEPOL)¹, and in particular Articles 10(9)(c) and 15(5) thereof;

Having regard to the proposal of the Director;

Having regard to its Decision 33/2015/GB Adopting the Single Programming Document for the Years 2016 – 2018;

Considering the proposal of the European Security and Defence College;

Considering the pressing training needs regarding the Policy Cycle and the request from the EMPACT Expert Group on combating online Child Sexual Exploitation within the Operational Action Plan 2016;

It is intended to use any underspend during 2016, in the budget for courses, to implement these additional activities.

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION

Article 1

Add to the list of the residential activities 2016 the following courses:

1. “Investigation on Darknet and Virtual Currencies”, in the area of Cyber Attacks, organised together with EMPACT driver for Cyber Attacks, the European Cybercrime Training and Education Group (ECTEG), Interpol, Europol and supporting countries.
2. “Schengen Evaluation” in the area of European Union tools for police cooperation and information exchange.
