OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN POLICE COLLEGE

**ON THE ADOPTION OF IMPLEMENTING RULE ON AMENDING ARTICLE 7(5) AND (7)
OF COMMISSION DECISION C(2009)10224 OF 18 DECEMBER 2009 CONCERNING
THE IMPLEMENTATION OF TELEWORKING IN COMMISSION DEPARTMENTS FROM
2010 TO 2015**

THE GOVERNING BOARD

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Union (CEOS), laid down by Council Regulation (EEC, EURATOM, ECSC) No 259/68, and in particular to Article 110 of the Staff Regulations,

Having regard to Council Decision (EC) 2005/681/JHA of 20 September 2005 establishing the European Police College (CEPOL) and repealing Decision 2000/820/JHA as last modified by Regulation (EU) No 543/2014 of the European Parliament and the Council of 15 May 2014, and in particular Article 10(9)(f) thereof,

After consultation of the Staff Committee and pursuant to Article 110 of the Staff Regulations,

Whereas:

- (1) The Governing Board of CEPOL adopted Decision 07/2007/GB setting out implementing rules to the Staff Regulations in agreement with the European Commission pursuant to Article 110 of the Staff Regulations;
- (2) The European Commission amended its implementing rules to the Staff Regulations, adopting Commission Decision C (2013) 9045 of 16 December 2013 amending Article 7(5) and (7) of Commission Decision C(2009)10224 of 18 December 2009 concerning the implementation of teleworking in Commission departments from 2010 to 2015;
- (3) CEPOL should amend its implementing rules accordingly;

HAS ADOPTED THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Article 1

Commission Decision C(2013)9045 of 16 December 2013 amending Article 7(5) and (7) of Commission Decision C(2009)10224 of 18 December 2009 concerning the implementation of teleworking in Commission departments from 2010 to 2015 shall apply by analogy.

Article 2

This Decision shall take effect on the day following that of its adoption by the Governing Board.
