

DECISION 17/2016/GB

OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN POLICE COLLEGE

**AMENDING THE ANNUAL WORK PROGRAMME 2016:  
ADDING TWO RESIDENTIAL ACTIVITIES**

Adopted by the Governing Board via written procedure  
on 17 June 2016

THE GOVERNING BOARD,

Having regard to Council Decision 2005/681/JHA of 20 September 2005 establishing the European Police College (CEPOL)<sup>1</sup>, and in particular Articles 10(9)(c) and 15(5) thereof;

Having regard to the proposal of the Director;

Having regard to its Decision 33/2015/GB Adopting the Single Programming Document for the Years 2016 – 2018;

Considering the proposal of the Customs Cooperation Working Party and EMPACT expert group Counterfeit goods;

Considering the proposal of the European Judicial Training Network;

It is intended to use any underspend during 2016, in the budget for courses, to implement these additional activities.

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION

*Article 1*

Add to the list of the residential activities 2016 the following courses:

1. “Online smuggling – Trafficking from customs perspective”, in the area of Counterfeit Goods, organised together with CCWP and EMPACT driver for Counterfeit goods and supporting countries.
2. “Follow the money - financial investigations” in cooperation with the European Judicial Training Network.
