Working group 1 Prisons and probation



- enhancing rehabilitation of violent extremist and terrorist offenders (VETOs),
- developing effective risk assessment,
- reviewing prison regimes and exit programmes

Working group 2 Foreign terrorist fighters and returnees



- increasing information sharing between LE agencies on modus operandi of FTF and border control,
- developing and implementing rehabilitation and reintegration programs for returnees and their families

Working group 3 Strategic communications



- countering extremists and terrorist propaganda
- promoting alternative narrative campaigns with the highlight on positive messages
- enhancing cooperation with civil society

Working group 4 Prevention/countering violent extremism



- promoting community policing and multiagency cooperation
- developing capacity building to reduce risks of radicalisation
- supporting conflict prevention mechanisms

Working group 5 Countering terrorism financing



- countering underground banking
- endorsing money tracing and asset recovery actions
- countering misuse of non-profit sector

Working group 6 Nexus terrorism organised crime



- disrupting relationship between terrorism and organised crime
- identifying links of action fields from terrorism and organised crime groups

Working group 7 Cyber threats



- countering online recruitment/propaganda
- increasing awareness on cybersecurity
- proposing regulatory requirements related to new technological developments

Working group 8 Critical infrastructure, hybrid threats, weapons and explosives



- identifying primary and secondary threats
- improving security and resilience of vulnerable targets
- preventing use of illicit weapons and explosives
