THE MANAGEMENT BOARD,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2015/2219 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 November 2015 on the European Union Agency for Law Enforcement Training (CEPOL) and replacing and repealing Council Decision 2005/681/JHA¹, and in particular Articles 34 and 36 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) The European Monitoring Centre for Drugs and Drug Addiction (EMCDDA), governed by its founding Regulation (EC) No 1920/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 12 December 2006 on the European Monitoring Centre for Drugs and Drug Addiction (recast), is a key partner for CEPOL;
- (2) There is a growing need for cooperation between EMCDDA and CEPOL that requires an institutionalised basis;
- (3) A draft Working Arrangement has been negotiated with EMCDDA;
- (4) The consultation with the European Commission under Article 34 paragraph (5) of the Regulation was completed and the Commission delivered its Opinion C(2022) 2414 final on 22 April 2022

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Single Article

The Executive Director is herewith authorised to conclude the Working Arrangement with the European Monitoring Centre for Drugs and Drug Addiction, annexed to this Decision.

The present Decision shall take effect on the day of its adoption.
