ON DELIVERING AN OPINION ON THE FINAL ANNUAL ACCOUNTS 2021

Adopted by the Management Board on 24 June 2022



THE MANAGEMENT BOARD,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2015/2219 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 November 2015 on the European Union Agency for Law Enforcement Training (CEPOL) and replacing and repealing Council Decision 2005/681/JHA¹, and in particular Article 20 (4) (5) thereof,

Having regard to Decision 13/2019/MB of the Managing Board of the European Union Agency for Law Enforcement Training (CEPOL) adopting the Financial Regulation and repealing decision 01/2014/GB, and in particular Article 102 thereof:

Having regard to the Court of Auditors opinion on the Provisional Annual Accounts 2021, thereof;

Having received and taken note of the Final Annual Accounts 2021 prepared by the Accounting Officer and drawn up by the Director, thereof;

HAS DECIDED:

- 1. To give a favourable opinion on the Final Annual Accounts 2021 of the European Union Agency for Law Enforcement Training (CEPOL), by having a reasonable assurance that the Accounts present a true and fair view of the financial situation of the Agency in all material aspects, and
- 2. That the Final Annual Accounts 2021 provide a basis for the discharge of the Director of the European Union Agency for Law Enforcement Training CEPOL for 2021.
