THE MANAGEMENT BOARD,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2015/2219 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 November 2015 on the European Union Agency for Law Enforcement Training (CEPOL) and replacing and repealing Council Decision 2005/681/JHA<sup>1</sup>, and in particular Articles 34 and 36 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) Norway is an associated member of the Schengen Area and participates in the related forms of cross-border law enforcement cooperation;
- (2) There is a growing need for cooperation between the Norway and CEPOL that requires an updated institutionalised basis;
- (3) A draft Working Arrangement has been negotiated with the Norwegian Police University College;
- (4) The consultation with the European Commission under Article 34 paragraph (5) of the Regulation was completed

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

## Single Article

The Executive Director is herewith authorised to conclude the Working Arrangement with the Norwegian Police University College, annexed to this Decision.

The present Decision shall take effect on the day of its adoption.
