**ON THE AUTHORISATION OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO
CONCLUDE A WORKING ARRANGEMENT BETWEEN THE MINISTRY OF
INTERNAL AFFAIRS OF UKRAINE AND CEPOL**

THE MANAGEMENT BOARD,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2015/2219 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 November 2015 on the European Union Agency for Law Enforcement Training (CEPOL) and replacing and repealing Council Decision 2005/681/JHA¹, and in particular Articles 34 and 36 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) Ukraine is a partner country of the European Union under the European Neighbourhood Policy;
- (2) There is a growing need for cooperation between Ukrainian law enforcement agencies and CEPOL that requires an institutionalised basis;
- (3) A draft Working Arrangement has been negotiated with the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Ukraine;
- (4) The consultation with the European Commission under Article 34 paragraph (5) of the Regulation was completed

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Single Article

The Executive Director is herewith authorised to conclude the Working Arrangement with the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Ukraine, annexed to this Decision.

The present Decision shall take effect on the day of its adoption.
