

Decision of the Management Board 35/2017/MB

On the authorisation of the Executive Director to conclude a working arrangement between the European Union Intellectual Property Office and CEPOL

THE MANAGEMENT BOARD,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2015/2219 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 November 2015 on the European Union Agency for Law Enforcement Training (CEPOL) and replacing and repealing Council Decision 2005/681/JHA¹, and in particular Article 34 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) It is CEPOL's interest to conclude a Working Arrangement with the European Union Intellectual Property Office (EUIPO) in order to formalise and further develop existing co-operation and the draft thereof has been negotiated with the EUIPO
- (2) The consultation with the European Commission under Article 34 paragraph (5) of the Regulation was completed

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Single Article

The Executive Director is herewith authorised to conclude the Working Arrangement with the EUIPO annexed to this Decision.

The present Decision shall take effect on the day of its adoption.
