
Structure

Master degree: 2 academic years120 ECTS + Probation period (7m)


Training of officers who have been promoted to

The training provided in the National Police Academy has been adapted to the University Pedagogic methods.


In the National Police Academy are also trained other police forces: Madrid Local Police and Castilla-León Local Police.

Relation with other countries


Iberpol. Its permanent Secretariat is in Ávila and it involves 18 Latin American countries, with the aim of training and cooperating against Organized Crime.

In the National Police Academy Training course for Police Inspectors are also trained officers from other countries.

In <u>2015</u> the following nationalities were represented: Algeria, Chile, Colombia, Morocco, Mauritania, Mexico, Niger and Peru.

In 2016 five students from Chile and Mexico will be trained in our facilities.





Higher Police Studies Centre – Madrid

In the beautiful building that hosts the Higher Police Studies Centre are also located the Updating and Specialization Centre and the Selection Processes Area.

The building was firstly intended to host the College of Orphans of the National Police.

During the Spanish Civil War it was used as a Military Hospital.

The building preserves intact its original appearance





Higher Police Studies Centre - Madrid

In this Centre training is given to officers who have been promoted to Chief Inspector, Superintendent or Commissioner, the future Heads of the National Police.

The training is provided by officers of the most renowed units and in some specific matters cooperation is requested from well known professionals (University Professors, technicians, magistrates...)

Higher Police Studies Centre – Madrid

In this Centre are also made the textbooks and exams for those students who intend to promote.

More than 1500 police officers interested in promoting are called to the updating exams every year.

For the first time, the Heads of the Local Police from Madrid were trained in our premises. 22 officers of the highest rank of the Local Police were trained in a five month course (390 hours).

The course was initiated in January 2016 (390 hours) and the second edition will start in January 2017.



Police Studies Institute- Madrid

It is part of the Higher Police Studies Centre and its main tasks are the following:

• Gather information and analyze <u>social needs</u> having to do with the National Police Corp duties.

• Cooperation with <u>Universities</u> and other Scientific Institution for developping courses and projects.

• Investigation, promotion and development of <u>new methods and</u> <u>professional proceedings</u>.


Updating & Specialization Centre - Madrid

These facilities are mainly used by the Riot Units, the Bomb Disposal Experts and the Prevention and Reaction Units.





Selection Processes - Madrid


The exams for those who have applied to join the National Police are very similar: a knowledge test, a physical training exam, an aptitude test and a personal interview. Those candidates who want to join the Police as Inspector need to do additional exams, a test to assess their English or French skills and also a case study.







For those officers who intend to promote the type of examination depends on the professional level they are promoting to.

The different Police Centers Involved follow this scheme:






The implementation of a TRAINING PROGRAMME

The main goal is a WELL TRAINED POLICE. The training is fully achived if the Police officer gets a personal enrichment.








The main challenges of the future
