Description of the services

CEPOL –The European Union Agency for Law Enforcement Training intends to launch in February 2017 a negotiated procurement procedure to award a service contract for the provision of **Police English Language (PEL) service in the domain of the two lots described above.**

Objective of the contract

CEPOL wishes to conclude a service contract the overall objective of which is to provide CEPOL in a timely and efficient manner with the following range of services:

- Design, develop, implement and evaluate the Police English Language Online Course in the period of April-June 2018 (Lot 1)
- Design and develop an online learning modules on Police English Language that shall be launched in 2018 (Lot 2)

All the above mentioned requires the provision of external trainer and language training development services for the successful implementation. The online course shall be hosted on the CEPOL Learning Management System (LMS) on e-Net. The online module shall either be hosted on the same LMS or be accessible via the LMS. Content to be used in both the Police English Language online course and the online modules are available from CEPOL.

The aim of this call for tender is to offer language learning opportunities to the learners of CEPOL, using innovative solutions to reach the maximum impact on this training activity.

The indicative budget for all costs associated with the performance of the contracts is maximum €52,500 (excluding VAT) for the 2 lots combined (€20,000 for Lot 1 and €32,500 for Lot 2).

Description of the procedure:

This ex-ante publicity is the first stage of a negotiated procedure with at least 3 economic operators through which CEPOL may award the above-mentioned contracts¹
