CEPOL is an agency of the European Union dedicated to developing, implementing and coordinating training for law enforcement officials. We bring together a network of training institutes for law enforcement officials in EU Member States and support them in providing frontline training on security priorities, law enforcement cooperation and information exchange. CEPOL also works with EU bodies, international organisations, and third countries to ensure that the most serious security threats are tackled with a collective response.



The Agency's Management System has been assessed by an independent accredited body Lloyd's Register (LRQA), and found in full compliance with the ISO 9001:2015 requirements.

RESIDENTIAL TRAINING ACTIVITIES

Courses, conferences and seminars typically lasting a week and held in training institutes in EU Member States or at CEPOL's premises.

ONLINE LEARNING

CEPOL's enhanced online learning platform, **LEEd**, is open to all EU law enforcement officials and is free to use. We provide interactive webinars, dedicated online courses with trainer's supervision as well as training modules for self-paced studying.

CEPOL EXCHANGE PROGRAMME

Our European mobility programme allows law enforcement officials to spend one week with a counterpart from another country, exchanging knowledge and good practices, initiating cooperation projects and fostering deep and long-lasting learning and networking opportunities.

CAPACITY BUILDING PROJECTS

In cooperation with international partners, we deliver capacity building projects in the EU's neighbourhood, such as:

- Project CT INFLOW, enhancing information exchange and Criminal Justice Responses related to terrorism in the EU South Neighbourhood countries
- Project EUROMED Police, enhancing institutional capacity in the EU South Neighbourhood countries to fight organized crime
- Project WB PaCT, enhancing the capacity of Western Balkan countries to fight organised crime and terrorism
- Project TOPCOP, strengthening strategic and operational cooperation in the Eastern Partnership countries to fight against organized crime

RESEARCH AND SCIENCE

We work closely with a variety of research institutions within the European Union to support research on law enforcement and to facilitate knowledge sharing. We publish and provide free access to scientific materials for all law enforcement officials.
