Description of the services

CEPOL – The European Union Agency for Law Enforcement Training – intends to launch in May 2018 a negotiated procurement procedure to award a service contract for the **e-Learning module content development services**.

Objective of the contract

The aim of this call for tender is to find a partner that produces the “CEPOL Induction” e-learning module targeting new employees of CEPOL or existing staff who move into a new role within the organisation. The selected partner shall:

1. design and develop an **e-learning module** that introduces CEPOL and enhances staff capability while reduces ‘time to autonomy’;
2. introduce a dynamic, innovative, engaging and user-friendly product showcased by the Induction e-learning module.

The indicative budget for all costs associated with the performance of the contracts is maximum €20,000 (excluding VAT).

Description of the procedure:

This ex-ante publicity is the first stage of a negotiated procedure with at least 3 economic operators through which CEPOL may award the above-mentioned contract¹.

This publication has an indicative value and constitutes no obligation for CEPOL.

All economic operators interested in providing the above services may express their interest by sending an e-mail with the subject “**CEPOL/2018/EAP/004 – e-Learning module content development**” to tenders@cepol.europa.eu together with their name, address and business details no later than **7 May 2018**.

The economic operators should demonstrate in their expression of interest that they have the necessary experience and capacity to provide the services described above.
