Description of the services

Subject: Provision of the work for Danube room sound attenuation

CEPOL – The European Union Agency for Law Enforcement Training intends to launch in February 2021 a negotiated procurement procedure to award a single direct service contract for the provision of the works for Danube room sound attenuation.

Objective of the contract

The objective of the contract is to select a contractor which is able to provide the architectural works for Danube room sound attenuation at CEPOL HQ (H-1066 Budapest, O utca 27).

The maximum possible duration of the works shall be 2 months from the start date of implementation, as communicated by CEPOL to the successful tenderer. In any event, works shall be completed no later than 31 August 2021.

The indicative budget for all costs associated with the performance of the contract is €45,000 (excluding VAT).

Description of the procedure:

This ex ante publicity is the first stage of a negotiated procedure with at least 3 economic operators through which CEPOL may award the above-mentioned contract.¹

- Annual turnover of at least €30,000.-
- Experience and expertise in the following areas:
 - o The tenderer must have a minimum experience of at least 3 years in providing the services in the field of architectural works as stated in the Tender Specifications, and their professional capacity shall be appropriate to the required services.

More details with regards to the technical requirements, the selection criteria and the means of proof as well as the award criteria will be provided in the invitation to tender and tender specifications.

All economic operators interested in providing the above services and having the above listed capacities may express their interest by sending an e-mail with the subject “**CEPOL/2021/EAP/001 – Provision of the works for Danube room sound attenuation**” to tenders@cepol.europa.eu together with their name, address and business details **no later than 12 February 2021**.
