

**Decision of the Management Board 42/2017/MB**

**On the voting for the appointment of the Executive Director of CEPOL**

**Adopted by the Management Board**

**on 19 December 2017**

## THE MANAGEMENT BOARD,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2015/2219 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 November 2015 establishing the European Union Agency for Law Enforcement Training (CEPOL) and replacing and repealing Council Decision 2005/681/JHA<sup>1</sup>, and in particular Article 23 thereof,

Having regard to Regulation No 31 (EEC), 11 (EAEC), laying down the Staff Regulations of Officials and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants (CEOS) of the European Economic Community and the European Atomic Energy Community<sup>2</sup>, and in particular Articles 2(a) and 12(2) of CEOS,

Having regard to the Decision of the Management Board 07/2017/MB laying down rules on the selection and the appointment of the Executive Director of CEPOL, and in particular Articles 4 and 5 thereof,

Having regard to the vacancy notice for the Executive Director of CEPOL (Grade AD 14)<sup>3</sup> published by the European Commission,

### Whereas:

- (1) The vacancy notice for the position of the Executive Director of CEPOL was published in the Official Journal of the European Union on 30 June 2017 with a deadline for applications of 30 July 2017.
- (2) The Selection Committee appointed by the Management Board on 10 May 2017 (06/2017/MB), invited 6 applicants possessing the best profile for the specific requirements of the post to an assessment centre that took place on 23 October, 27 October and 31 October 2017.
- (3) Above-mentioned candidates were subsequently interviewed by the Selection Committee on 10 November 2017.
- (4) On the basis of the results of the interviews, and taking into consideration the results of the assessment centre, the Selection Committee drew up a list of 3 candidates.

- (5) The 3 candidates were invited for an interview with the Management Board in the context of an extraordinary Management Board meeting that took place on 19 December 2017.
- (6) Following these interviews, the Management Board voted in accordance with the procedure described in the vacancy notice and further detailed in Article 5 of the Decision 07/2017 MB.

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

*Article 1*

Mr Detlef SCHROEDER is appointed as Executive Director of CEPOL. The term of office shall start on 16 February 2018.

*Article 2*

This Decision shall take effect on 16 February 2018.
