Subject: Ex-ante publicity in a negotiated procurement procedure

CEPOL – the European Police College intends to launch in May 2016 a negotiated procurement procedure to award a framework service contract for the provision of courier services with a maximum duration of 4 years.

Objective of the contract

The contractor will provide domestic and international courier services on CEPOL's request for urgent and/or delicate deliveries, which must reach their destination in the shortest time period possible.

The volume of the contract for its entire duration is estimated €40,000 (excluding VAT) for all costs associated with the performance of the contract.

Description of the procedure:

All economic operators interested in providing the above services may express their interest by sending an e-mail with the subject "CEPOL/2016/EAP/006 – Courier services" to tenders@cepol.europa.eu together with their name, address and business details no later than **9 May 2016**.

The economic operators should demonstrate in their expression of interest that they have the necessary experience and capacity to provide the services described above.
