

DECISION
OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN POLICE COLLEGE
10/2006/GB
CONCERNING THE DEVELOPMENT
OF THREE NEW COMMON CURRICULA IN 2006

Adopted by the Governing Board
on 23 February 2006

THE GOVERNING BOARD,

Having regard to the Council Decision 2005/681/JHA of 20 September 2005 establishing a European Police College (hereinafter referred to as “CEPOL”), and in particular Article 10(10) thereof;

Having regard to CEPOL’s Annual Work Programme 2006 as endorsed by the Council on its 2674th meeting in Brussels;

Having regard to the proposal of the Annual Programme Committee and the Training and Research Committee;

Whereas:

- (1) CEPOL’s Annual Work Programme 2006 provides for the development of new Common Curricula programmes.
- (2) It is appropriate to mandate ad hoc working groups to develop new programmes.
- (3) Therefore three new ad hoc working groups shall be established.

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

Decision 6/2006/GB of the Governing Board of the European Police College is hereby amended as follows:

The following paragraphs are added to Article 5:

- ‘(e) Common Curriculum Money Laundering
- (f) Common Curriculum Trafficking of Human Beings
- (g) Common Curriculum Domestic Violence’.

CEPOL – Development of 3 new Common Curricula in 2006

Article 2

The leading position for the development shall be taken over by

- (a) Portugal for Money Laundering
- (b) Lithuania for Trafficking of Human Being
- (c) Germany for Domestic Violence

Article 3

This decision shall take effect on the day following that of its adoption.
