OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN POLICE COLLEGE

**CONCERNING CEPOL'S APPROACH ON**

**POST-COURSE LEARNING REINFORCEMENT**

Adopted by the Governing Board  
on 28 November 2007

THE GOVERNING BOARD,

Having regard to Council Decision 2005/681/JHA of 20 September 2005 establishing the European Police College (CEPOL) <sup>(1)</sup>, and in particular Article 7 thereof;

Having regard to the proposal from the Training and Research Committee <sup>(2)</sup>, submitted by Spain;

Whereas:

- (1) The development of a proposal for creating systematic post-course activities for participants of CEPOL activities is an assignment to the Working Group on Learning in the Action Plan of the Training and Research Committee;
- (2) CEPOL aims at improving the quality and effectiveness of training;

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

*Article 1*  
*Approach on Post-Course Learning Reinforcement*

Post-Course Learning Reinforcement shall be considered in CEPOL's vision on learning and therefore it shall be considered in all learning and training activities and be reflected in related documents <sup>(3)</sup>.

*Article 2*  
*Entry into force*

This decision shall take effect on the day following that of its adoption.
