

DECISION 34b /2007/GB
OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN POLICE COLLEGE
CONCERNING THE SUPPLY OF THE SERVICES OF MODULE ADVISORS

Adopted by the Governing Board
on 28 November 2007

THE GOVERNING BOARD,

Having regard to Decision 29/2006/GB of the Governing Board of the European Police College laying down the Common Curriculum Policy ⁽¹⁾, and in particular No 4.3.2 thereof;

Having regard to the proposal of the Director;

Whereas:

- (1) For each Common Curriculum a module adviser needs to be appointed by the Governing Board on a proposal of the Director for the updating and further development as well as the support for the national implementation of the Common Curricula.
- (2) The appointment of module advisors for six Common Curricula has been proposed to the Governing Board. However, no suitable candidate could be proposed as a module advisor for the Common Curriculum “European Police Cooperation”. Two out of three nominated candidates could not offer the required combination of knowledge on legal issues and on European Police Cooperation as well as training experience. One out of three candidates would have the qualifications, but was also nominated as the module advisor for the Common Curriculum “Europol” for which he was more suitable.
- (3) The Common Curriculum “European Police Cooperation” is very complex and extensive. Therefore it requires more attention than other Common Curricula.
- (4) For Common Curricula where the workload is estimated at more than 50 % of one full-time equivalent an appropriate alternative to a service contract with the national police training institute, which employs the appointed candidate is to second the appointed candidate to the CEPOL Secretariat as national expert, what may attract a wider range of candidates.
- (5) It is therefore desirable to amend Decision 29/2006/GB accordingly.

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

*Article 1
Amendment*

After Paragraph 4 of No 4.3.2 of Decision 29/2006/GB of the Governing Board of the European Police College laying down the Common Curriculum Policy ⁽¹⁾ the following paragraph is inserted:

“In case the workload is estimated at more than 50 % of one full-time equivalent the Director of CEPOL and the national police training institute, which employs the appointed candidate may alternatively agree to second the appointed candidate to the CEPOL Secretariat in accordance with Article 13(5) of Council Decision 2005/681/JHA of 20 September 2005 establishing the European Police College (CEPOL) ⁽¹⁾ with the appointed candidate’s prior consent.
