

DECISION 33/2010/GB
OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN POLICE COLLEGE

ADOPTION OF NON POSTPONEMENT OF ACTIVITIES

Adopted by the Governing Board
on 28 September 2010

THE GOVERNING BOARD,

Having regard to Council Decision 2005/681/JHA of 20 September 2005 establishing the European Police College (CEPOL) ⁽¹⁾, and in particular Article 11 (4f) thereof;

Having regard to the proposal by Director;

Having regard to the advise of the Strategy Committee ²;

Whereas:

Postponement from one calendar year to the following one jeopardises sound financial management;

There is a need for stability in the implementation of the programme of courses, seminars and conferences.

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

Courses, Seminars and Conferences that are not implemented in the scheduled calendar year will not be postponed to the next one, unless in a situation of force majeure to the discretion of the Director.

By means of force majeure natural disasters, political instability or the other situations of extraordinary character, like pandemics, serious economical crises or any other exceptional circumstances may be understood.

Insufficient participation will not be considered to be force majeure. Moreover, the organizing academy will have to prove that the best effort has been done at both quality and administrative levels i.e. invitation send on time, detailed course descriptor available on time, content related to the title of the activity, balance between ex-cathedra presentations and workshop/action learning/...


Article 2
