OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN POLICE COLLEGE

WRITTEN PROCEDURE FOR BUDGET TRANSFERS

Adopted by the Governing Board
on 29 September 2010

THE GOVERNING BOARD,

Having regard to Council Decision 2005/681/JHA of 20 September 2005 establishing the European Police College (CEPOL) ⁽¹⁾, and in particular Article 11, 16 and 17 thereof;

Having regard to CEPOL's Financial Regulations and its Implementing Rules² and in particular art. 3 and article 23 thereof

Having Regard to the Commission Financial Regulation³

Having regard to the proposal by the Head of Administration;

Having Regard to the advise of the Strategy Committee⁴;

Whereas:

Measures have been implemented with the Secretariat to improve the management of the CEPOL budget in respect of the legitimate expectations of the European Commission, European Parliament and the Court of Auditors that budgetary appropriations will be managed.

In order to meet the administrative and operational needs of the organisation, decisions on the transfer of funds must be made in a timely manner.

Clarification of the rules of procedure implied by the CEPOL Financial Regulations and its Implementing Rules and Commission Financial Regulations is required.

Written Procedure


