OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN POLICE COLLEGE
**ESTABLISHING A POLICY CONCERNING THE ACCESSIBILITY OF
THE COMMON CURRICULA TO THIRD PARTIES**

Adopted by the Governing Board
on 30 September 2010

CEPOL - Establishing A Policy Concerning The Accessibility Of The Common Curricula To Third Parties

THE GOVERNING BOARD,

Having regard to Council Decision 2005/681/JHA of 20 September 2005 establishing the European Police College (CEPOL) ⁽¹⁾, and in particular Article 10(10) thereof;

Having regard to the official requests by different third parties for the use of the Common Curricula.

Whereas:

- (1) There is a growing interest in the Common Curricula expressed by Third Parties;
- (2) These Third Parties include non-EU countries; other EU agencies; international organisations and agencies involved in activities which relate to the Common Curricula topics;
- (3) Sharing the Common Curricula with these Third Parties is beneficial to EU-wide multi-disciplinary and police cooperation;
- (4) It is therefore desirable to adopt the following decision.

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1
Accessibility

The Common Curricula, after adoption by the Governing Board, will be made accessible upon request to the following Third Parties:

- Non-EU countries
- Other EU agencies
- International agencies involved in activities which relate to the Common Curricula topics;

*Article 2
Procedure*

The decision which Third Parties are given access to which Common Curriculum(a) is at the responsibility of the Director. If there is no existing cooperation agreement between CEPOL and the Third Party, a specific agreement regulating the use of the Common Curricula will be drawn up and signed by both parties.

The Governing Board will be informed about such agreements.

Article 3

This Decision shall take effect on the day following that of its adoption.
